Charles Campbell Gallery Closing and Going Out of Business

Recently Charles Campbell and I reached a settlement dissolving our partnership. With deep regret I announce that the Gallery is going out of business and closing in April. In our settlement we agreed that retroactively, since January 1st, 2007, I have been the sole owner of the Campbell Gallery and am the successor in interest of the business. I have been operating these past two years with my domestic partner Eric Koehler as Gallery Manager.

Charlie is retired and he and Mrs. Campbell wish to sell the Chestnut Street property. They have asked us to vacate before the end of April and will not sell the building to us. I hoped to announce a new location along with news of our closing, except that we don't have one – yet.

Eric and I are exploring opening our own gallery here in the city. We will post information here on our website, please visit us for news and information. Our artists' works will continue to be available and you can still reach us easily and on familiar ground because we retain the website, email addresses and phone numbers.

Saturday April 5th 2008 will be our last day of operation on Chestnut Street. We've scheduled a "Partners Sale" and a show of small paintings by William Rushton to run through our close date. We will continue to offer work through April 5th.

Thank you for your support of our artists, the Gallery and me and Eric. It has been our privilege to work with talented and inspiring artists, and so many wonderful clients and friends of this Gallery. Thank you so very much and please watch for us in a new space.
